SLOW FOOD COMMUNITY FOUNDING DECLARATION

We, the undersigned,
state:

That good, clean and fair food is the inalienable right of everyone and as long as this right is denied to even one person on the planet, we will not stop fighting for it;

That food plays a central role not only in defining the quality of life of individuals and peoples, but also in the history, construction, and evolution of their culture and identity;

That safeguarding the environment is our priority and that promoting the biodiversity of the land and sea and a more sustainable food system are key actions against climate change;

That our everyday choices, starting with what we eat and feed others, can contribute to changing the world and to ensuring a better future for the generations to come;

That all people, wherever they are and whatever their circumstances, are able to support Slow Food with ideas, practical support, the dissemination of correct information, a commitment to raising awareness, and sustainable production and consumption choices.

We also recognize

the international Slow Food movement as an action model for the improvement and protection of the lives of everyone, for the defense of biodiversity and ecosystems, for the rebuilding of an ecological food culture, for environmental safeguarding, and for the fight against social and economic iniquities;

And

that a community, as the form of aggregation that represents and promotes a system based on knowledge, relationships, openness, inclusion, emotional security, and democracy, can be part of the solution to growing inequality, social injustice, and the global environmental crisis, and can create real change.

Therefore,

having gathered together on 27/07/2020 in ISERA, we declare our commitment:

- to being ambassadors and bearers of the values that the Slow Food movement embodies and promotes;
- to embracing and supporting a food system in harmony with human dignity, social justice, and respect for the environment and all living beings;
- to adhering to the principles contained in the Declaration of Chengdu, which we want to follow with our individual and collective actions.

A Slow Food community

- is formed by at least ten people, represented by a spokesperson, and organized by a coordinating group of at least five people;
- is established to pursue a specific objective, linked to the general goals of Slow Food;
- collaborates regularly with the local Slow Food network and produces an annual report for them and Slow Food HQ explaining the activities carried out, those planned for the future, and the main results achieved;
- manages and uses its name and logo in line with the Slow Food International Statute, the Code of Use for Slow Food Trademarks, and the Fundraising Guidelines, and only for the fulfillment of commitments related to its local objectives;
- bases its name on its principal activity and the name of the territory in which it operates;
- is committed to being transparent and be managed under a participatory democratic governance model;
- undertakes not to exercise, in the area in which it operates, rights of veto or exclusivity that could hinder new forms of activism and adherence to Slow Food principles by other bodies;
- must create paths for dialogue, sharing, and cooperation with other Slow Food entities, while maintaining the independence and autonomy of each group;
- according to its own circumstances, supports the Slow Food international network and its programs and projects;
- is open, inclusive, and able to welcome people of different backgrounds, incomes, and cultures, and commits to encouraging the participation of the widest possible number of people in its activities.

The general objective of the Slow Food Community (NAME) of producers and co-produces of Qa'en's saffron is:

- To support small Saffron producers in order to improve the terms of sale of Saffron and to help them receive a fair share of the profit, specifically in southern Khorasan, where harvesting Saffron is a family business.
- Try to improve the working condition in small villages to encourage the labor force, specially young people who immigrate to the cities because of the economical uncertainty of their family agricultural life.
- Educating rural citizens of southern Khorasan, specifically farmers about the international Saffron market.
- Educating rural citizens of southern Khorasan about the value of their culture and tradition

In order to achieve this general objective, we commit to:

- Create direct connection between the small producers of Saffron in southern Khorasan and buyers in Italy including markets, restaurants and other consumers in different ways such as:
- Exhibitions and educational workshops in different areas like, food, cooking and food tourism, dinners and photo and movie festivals.
- Organizing responsible travels to familiarize people with the harvest lands of Saffron, production culture and different ways of consumption with the help of local institutes.
- Create a network to connect the small producers of Saffron and the European market specifically Italy.
- Connecting producers of Saffron in Iran and Italy in to confront the problem of fake Saffron in the European market.
- Organizing marketing workshops for the local farmers in southern Khorasan to familiarize them with the expectation and qualitative standards of the European consumers.
- Educate the local farmers about the branding technique that has been used for the local European products supported by Slow Food, the advertising methods and the ways that they connect their products with their geographical and cultural identity.
- Advocating the usage of Saffron petals in handicrafts including Dyeing handwoven fabric.






2. SOURCES OF PERSONAL DATA

The provision of data is optional.

The willingness to belong to the community, expressed in the founding declaration and subsequent participation, requires the active involvement of members in the community and the legitimate interest of the parties in sending/receiving communications for the purposes expressed in point 3.b.

In the case of refusal to participate in the community, the purposes referenced in points 3.a (improving participation) and 3.b will be unable to be fulfilled.

5. PROCESSING METHODS

Data processing means the collection, recording, organization, storage, elaboration, modification, cancellation and destruction of the data or the combination or two or more such operations. In relation to the purposes referenced above, the processing of personal data can be carried out using manual, computerized and electronic instruments, strictly in relation to said purposes and, in any case, in such a way as to ensure security and privacy. In the case of authorization, data will be kept until the revocation of consent. In the case of refusal, they will be cancelled or anonymized.
